Policy Statement

No vehicle shall be permitted to enter the Site with an uncovered or unsecured load of waste. Any vehicle entering the Site with an uncovered or unsecured load shall be subject to the following procedures:

1. 1st Incident

The driver/company of the vehicle will be given a verbal warning.

2. 2nd Incident

The driver of the vehicle/company will be given a written warning and the load will be charged at 1 ½ times the full tipping fee for the load.

3. 3rd Incident

The driver/company will be banned from the site for an indefinite period which will be not less than 3 months. To re-institute disposal privileges, the generator will be required to make a direct appeal to the Authority.

4. Prior to any vehicle entering the site with an uncovered or unsecured load of waste, the scale clerk shall record the make, type and license plate number of the vehicle and a general description of the waste.
