



# Business Card Holder

## Materials list:

- Cassette tape case
- Photograph (no wider than the cassette case)
- Glue stick
- Double-sided tape
- Scissors
- Card stock for backing  
(we reused an old black file folder)



## Directions:

1. Fold back the cassette case so it sits on the desk as shown in the second photo.
2. Trim around the photo you've chosen and glue it onto the old file folder.
3. Trim again around the picture and allow extra space at the bottom if you need your picture to sit higher when the business cards are displayed. Use the width of the cassette case to measure how wide to make the bottom of the picture.
4. Use double-sided tape to secure the picture onto the plastic case and your business card holder is ready to use!



## Suggestions for use:

- ↪ This is a fairly easy craft and makes a good gift idea for Father's Day (or for anyone who uses business cards). Younger children will require assistance with the cutting.
- ↪ If you don't want to use a photo reuse your greeting cards. Some cards have pictures and artwork that is just too good to throw out, reuse it!
- ↪ Instead of business cards you can cut your scrap paper into pieces the size of a business card (wider is ok since there is extra width to the cassette case). Keep it by your phone so you always have paper for phone messages.
