



Clothes Pin Holder

Materials list:

- HDPE (#2) plastic jug (fabric softener or bleach bottles work best, rinse well)
- Sharp blade cutting tool
- Pen or marker

Directions:

1. Mark a cutting line in the center area of the jug in an oval pattern as shown in the photo.
2. Cut along the line. Cut the hand and remove and discard this piece.
3. Your jug is now a handy clothespin holder that will hook onto your outdoor clothesline. It slides along as you hang your clothes just reach in for your clothespins as needed. It hooks onto the side of your clothesbasket too.



Other suggestions for reuse of HDPE (#2 Plastic) jugs:

- ↪ HDPE jugs come in a variety of colours. They are great for storing small pieces of children's toys. Cut off the top completely below the handle, as it will not be required to hang. Cut out a picture of the toy the container is for and tape it onto the outside of the container to help the children replace the toys in the right container when it's time to tidy up.
- ↪ The top of the jug can be used as a large funnel. This funnel is popular with children for sand or water play. Adults will find it handy for pouring oil or paint through (minimizes the mess).
- ↪ Bring the cut bottom and top (keep the lid on for this) to the beach and use it to shape the sand to make awesome sand castles.
- ↪ Use the bottom of the container to mix paints when it's required for decorative faux painting techniques.
