Re: Temporary change in Designated Haul Route

The County of Essex has Tendered for the repair of a culvert under County 23 (Arner Townline) approximately 1 mile south of Highway No. 3 at the intersection with 9th Concession.

The Contractor expects to close CR 23 on September 24 for about 3 weeks.

Please check our website at www.ewswa.org for updated information.

We are suggesting that our customers consider some of the following detour routes and to **avoid using un-signalized intersections for the duration**. In discussion with the County they have suggested the following routes;

From County Road 25, turn right on CR46, then left onto CR23, through the roundabout then follow CR23 to the signalized intersection at Highway No.3. Turn right (east) on Highway No. 3 to CR27. Turn right (south) on CR27 and follow back to CR23 (Arner Townline).

From County Road 27 north, turn right on CR46, then left onto CR23, through the roundabout then follow CR23 to the signalized intersection at Highway No.3. Turn right (east) on Highway No. 3 to CR27. Turn right (south) on CR27 and follow back to CR23 (Arner Townline). We do not advise the use of CR27 all the way to CR23 (Arner) as the intersection with Highway No. 3 is not controlled.

From Manning Road north, turn left on Highway No. 3 to CR27. Turn right (south) on CR27 and follow back to CR23 (Arner Townline).

For Traffic from the West, use County Road 11 (Walker Road), then County Road 18 (east) to the Regional Landfill.
