

Essex Garbage Collection

- You will receive WEEKLY garbage collection. Please check below to identify which day your ward will receive garbage collection.
- Place GARBAGE out for collection the night BEFORE your scheduled collection day.
- Do NOT place yard waste out for garbage collection. It will NOT be picked up.
- Large Items and Furniture: Will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day (with the exception of white goods) - see right. Items such as boxsprings, mattresses, couches, chairs, and similar materials can be put out on any regular garbage day.
- If your garbage collection is missed, or if you have questions regarding your garbage collection (i.e.,
 – what is acceptable) please call Green For Life (GFL) at 519-944-8009.
- Unacceptable Garbage Containers: Do not place garbage out in containers that are oversized and overweight. Do not used plastic shopping bags or recyclable cardboard boxes. Containers cannot weigh over 20 kg / 45 lbs.
- NON-COLLECTABLE Waste: Waste that is deemed non-collectable includes: Ammunition, animal carcasses, animal waste, appliances, automotive parts, bricks, combustibles, chemical waste, computer equipment, concrete, construction & demolition waste, explosives, industrial waste, liquid waste, medical waste, metal items, pallets, paint products, renovation debris, syringes, televisions, and tires.

These items are not garbage and will NOT be collected – **check index for Public Drop Off information**.

- · Recommended size: 26" X 36"
- · Never put sharp objects in plastic bags

- Maximum 125L / 30 gal. capacity
- Maximum 78 cm/31" tall, 20" diameter
- · 2 handles and a water tight lid

White Goods / Appliances:

Collection of white goods is on the FIRST Thursday of every month. To be placed on a list for pick up, you MUST call 519-776-7336 ext. 1100 or 1101 - PRIOR to the Thursday collection date.

All calls must be received no later than Wednesday by noon.


White Goods include: metal items, hot water tanks, bbq's, bath tubs, sinks, etc.

Weekly Garbage Collection

AREA 1 MONDAY COLLECTION:

All properties south of County Rd. 18 - Ward 3 (former Colchester South) and Ward 4 (former Town of Harrow).

Look for this symbol.

AREA 2 WEDNESDAY COLLECTION:

All properties north of County Rd. 18 - Ward 1 (former Town of Essex) and Ward 2 (former Colchester North).

Look for this symbol.



Yard Waste Collection

WARD 1 - COMPOSTAINER / HERBY CURBY PROGRAM

Yard Waste is the ONLY material accepted in your compostainer / Herby Curby.

Recyclables go out for recycling collection - Blue Box (containers), Red Box (paper products).



Compostainer or Herby Curby (max. 45 lbs)

- Yard Waste: Grass, leaves, garden trimmings & vegetable peelings. The compostainer symbol indicates that you put your compostainer & yard waste out for collection. Herby Curby containers and other similar wheeled receptacles are accepted.
- Should you have extra yard waste that does not fit in your compostainer or Herby Curby, please put it in a paper yard waste bag, garbage can/pail or cardboard box and place it out for collection beside your compostainer / Herby Curby.



Materials NOT ACCEPTED in your compostainer:

Recyclables (go in Blue Box or Red Box), ashes & cigarette butts, foil/stretch wrap, plastic bags, diapers & feminine hygiene products, rocks & dirt, animal waste / kitty litter, uncooked meat or fish, paper towels (used in household cleaning), liquids (milk, oils, juices, etc.)

Hydrant Flushing



Seasonal hydrant flushing in the Town of Essex will be conducted as required from **April to November**. Hydrant flushing is a normal maintenance procedure and may result in customers experiencing rusty or milky water conditions. Please check when running water and if discolouration occurs, run cold water taps until the water clears.

Hydrant flushing will occur between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 pm.

All customers should note that flushing of watermains may be required without notification at various times throughout the year in order to ensure water quality.

Basic Collection Requirements:

Yard Waste Collection for Colchester Village Area plus those properties located on and to the south of County Road 50, Hidden Creek Condominiums and the Town of Harrow on the dates marked with a paper yard waste bag (symbol) throughout the calendar.

Residents outside the service area please call in for Yard Waste Collection at 519.776.7336 ext. 0 before noon on the Friday before a scheduled collection date.





Yard Waste Preparation:

Yard Waste is defined as leaves, grass clippings, tree trimmings, or garden waste.

Tree / Hedge Trimmings:

Cut in 4 ft. lengths (max. diameter 2 ft.) and bundled securely. Not to exceed 45 lbs.

Large tree trunks or stumps will NOT be picked up.


Vegetation / Garden Waste:

Flowers, vegetable plants and garden trimmings should be put in acceptable containers for collection (remove soil from roots).



Resident Alert System



Town of Essex Emergency Alert Program

Get alerted about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for Essex Alerts. This system enables us to provide you with critical information quickly in a variety of situations, such as unexpected road closures, evacuations of buildings or neighbourhoods.

You will receive time-sensitive messages in whatever format you prefer, such as your home, mobile or business phones, email address, text messages and more. Please note, depending on your mobile phone service provider, some fees may apply for receiving SMS messages.

The Town of Essex will regularly test the system to ensure delivery of messages to residents.

DOG TAGS

Did you know that dog tags help reunite owners with their pets quickly? Dog owners in the Town of Essex are required to renew their dog tag for each of their dogs (maximum three dogs per dwelling unit) every year. Owners of registered dogs are invoiced in January.



To avoid a late penalty, residents are encouraged to purchase their tags by March 31, 2026. Fees increase as of April 1st. The annual fee for renewals and new dogs is \$21.10. Fees increase to \$42.20 as of April 1st.

Dog Owners can now access their registration information and pay for their renewals online from the comfort of their home. Please visit www.essex.ca/pets for more information. Dog owners who do not have internet access can purchase or renew their dog tags at Town Hall, 33 Talbot Street South, Essex or at Harrow and Colchester South Community Centre (Arena), 243 McAffee Street. Harrow.

POINT - the arrows on the lid toward the street

PARK - the bin about 30 cm from the curb **SPACE** - the bin 1 meter from other objects










FLOODING

SUBSIDY PROGRAM

As a result of the increasingly frequent and severe weather events related to climate change, the Town of Essex has implemented subsidy programs to assist homeowners to reduce the risk of basement flooding on their private property.



The Town is offering owners of residential dwellings (single family and duplex homes) the opportunity to receive a financial subsidy to disconnect downspouts, complete investigative camera work, install a sump pump and/or back-water valve (flood protection devices), and purchase a rain barrel.



This Recycling Depot doesn't accept garbage, and Garden Gold Compost is not available for purchase.

WINTER GREEN BIN TIPS

Using the Green Bin all year makes a big difference.

Winter can be tricky, but following a few simple tips will help you stay green during the colder months.



TIPS TO PREVENT FREEZING

The Bottom Line? Line The Bottom!

Line the bottom of the Green Bin with food-soiled paper products or packaging such as egg cartons, takeout cartons, etc.

The Early Bird Doesn't Freeze.

If possible, set the Green Bin out **the morning of collection day by 6 a.m.,** not the night before.

Protect Your Bin - Bring It In.

Store the Green Bin in a garage or shed - or place it against an outside wall - to protect it from snow, ice and extreme temperatures.

TIPS FOR SET-OUT

Don't Bank On It!

Snowbanks can make it harder to set out the Green Bin. Be sure to place the Green Bin on a cleared, level area on your property along the street—never on top of snowbanks. Remember: always try to use **Park-Point-Space**.
