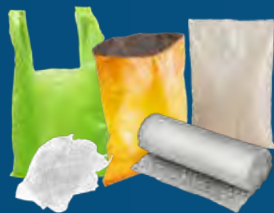

LaSalle Garbage Collection

- You will receive WEEKLY garbage collection on Tuesday or Friday (NOT both). Please check the list below to identify which day your street will receive garbage collection. Your garbage day will be identified by a garbage can icon.

- Place GARBAGE out for collection, the night before your scheduled collection day.
- Large Items & Furniture:** Will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day (with the exception of metal items/appliances). Items such as box springs, mattresses, couches, chairs, and similar materials can be put out on any regular garbage day. Please call GFL Environmental Inc. at 519-944-8009 to advise if you have a large item for pick up.
- If you have questions regarding your garbage collection (i.e. - what is acceptable) please call GFL Environmental Inc. at 519-944-8009.
- Unacceptable Garbage Containers:** Do not place garbage out in containers that are:
Oversized & Overweight: Containers cannot weigh over 20 kg / 45 lbs.
Plastic Shopping Bags: Do NOT place them at the curb.
Cardboard Boxes: Recycle or use for Yard Waste!
- NON-COLLECTABLE Waste:** Waste that is deemed non-collectable includes: Ammunition, animal carcasses, animal waste, appliances, automotive parts, bricks, combustibles, chemical waste, computer equipment, concrete, construction and demolition waste, explosives, industrial waste, liquid waste, medical waste, metal items, pallets, paint products, renovation debris, syringes, televisions, and tires. These items are not garbage and will NOT be collected – check index for Public Drop Off information.

Yard Waste Collection

Basic Collection Requirements:

- Yard Waste collection is EVERY OTHER WEEK beginning in April and ending in November (on Saturdays for the entire Town of LaSalle). Please refer to calendar for pick-up dates.



← Look for the Paper Yard Waste Bag (symbol). It will indicate your Yard Waste Collection Day.



← Look for the Leaf (symbol) in November. It will indicate your Leaf Collection Day.

The only **ACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS** for Yard Waste are:

- Paper Yard Waste Bags
- Cardboard Boxes
- Garbage Cans / Pails



No Plastic Bags for Yard Waste!

Yard Waste Preparation:

- Yard Waste is defined as grass, leaves, garden trimmings, brush and branches.

- Tree & Hedge Trimmings:**
Tied in bundles (max. length 4ft. / max. diameter 2 ft.)



- Garden Waste:**
Flowers, vegetables, pumpkins, plants, and fruit should be put in cardboard boxes, paper yard waste bags, or garbage pails/cans.

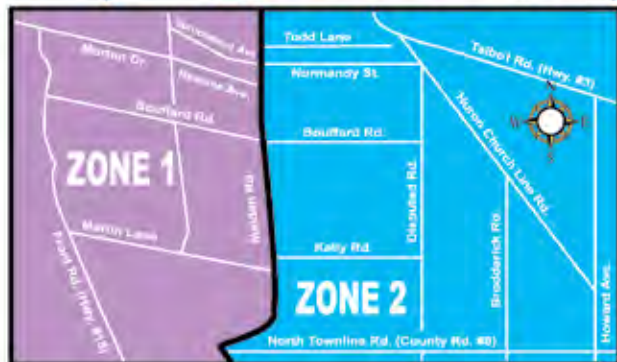
- Leaves:**
Leaves will be collected during the month of November. Do NOT put yard waste in with your leaves, or they will NOT be collected.

- Christmas Trees:**
Remove ornaments, bags and stands. Recycle your Christmas Tree at one of the designated depots (see list below):

- River Canard Park (Malden Rd.)
- LaSalle Landing (Front Rd.)
- Optimist Park (Victory St.)
- Heritage Park (Heritage Dr.)
- Vince Marcotte Park (LaSalle St. and Normandy Rd.)
- Public Works Building (Judy Recker Dr.)

ZONE 1

every other Tuesday

All properties WEST of Malden Rd.

(includes the WEST side of Malden Rd.)

ZONE 2

every other Monday

All properties EAST of Malden Rd.

(includes the EAST side of Malden Rd.)

Recycling Days:

LaSalle recycling collection is divided into zones (see map above).

Zone 1: Recycling collection is every other **Tuesday**.

Zone 2: Recycling collection is every other **Monday**.

Grass Clippings

Try grasscycling! Leave them on your lawn.

If you must place grass clippings out, put them in garbage pails.
Do NOT use plastic bags.

Grass clippings will be collected until the last Yard Waste collection day in November.

Grass clippings placed out for regular garbage collection will NOT be picked up.

Leaf Collection

Leaves will be collected in November. **Please see the calendar**, as indicated by the leaf symbol. **The entire Town of LaSalle will be picked up on these dates.** Leaves must be placed out for collection in approved containers.

Leaves will NOT be collected in plastic bags. Bags containing garbage or yard waste will NOT be picked up.

Place your leaves out for collection on the night before your scheduled leaf collection days.






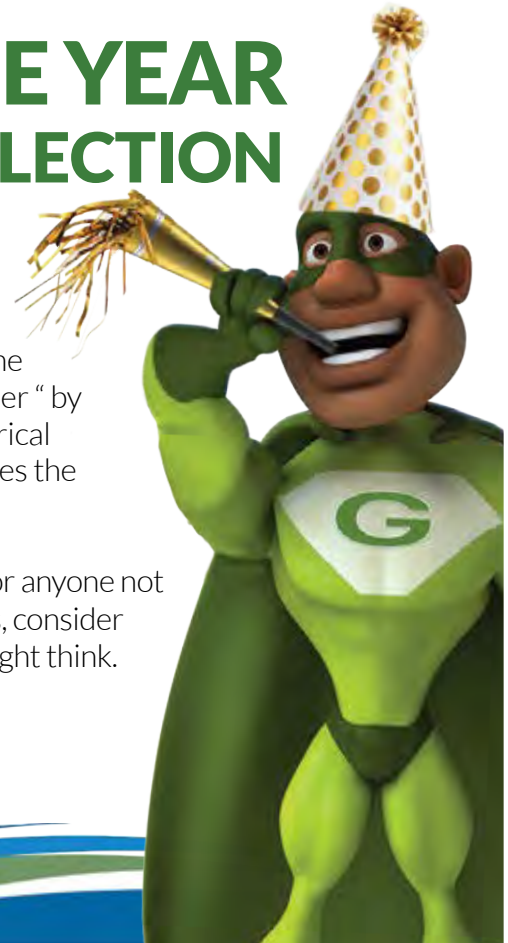

TIPS TO PREVENT FREEZING

The Bottom Line? Line The Bottom!

Line the bottom of the Green Bin with food-soiled paper products or packaging such as egg cartons, takeout cartons, etc.

The Early Bird Doesn't Freeze.

If possible, set the Green Bin out **the morning of collection day by 6 a.m.**, not the night before.

Protect Your Bin - Bring It In.

Store the Green Bin in a garage or shed - or place it against an outside wall - to protect it from snow, ice and extreme temperatures.

TIPS FOR SET-OUT

Don't Bank On It!

Snowbanks can make it harder to set out the Green Bin. Be sure to place the Green Bin on a cleared, level area on your property along the street— never on top of snowbanks. Remember: always try to use **Park-Point-Space**.

Winter Roads Maintenance

During the winter months, main roads are cleared and salted first, followed by residential and secondary roads. Be sure to maintain a safe distance from snowplows and avoid pushing driveway snow back onto the road.

During winter snowfall, property owners are encouraged to:

- Park vehicles in driveways, not on the road.
- Maintain clear catch basins for proper drainage.
- Keep fire hydrants visible and snow-free.
- Clear sidewalks adjoining your property.
- Place garbage and recycle bins in the driveway approach, not on snow banks or the road.

Residents should wait to clear their driveway approaches until the plows have cleared the curb lanes.

Natural Christmas Tree Drop-Off

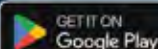
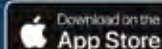
LaSalle residents are reminded that natural Christmas trees will not be collected with regular garbage. Drop off natural Christmas trees to the designated areas at:

- River Canard Park (Malden Rd.)
- LaSalle Landing (Front Rd.)
- Optimist Park (Victory St.)
- Heritage Park (Heritage Dr.)
- Vince Marcotte Park (LaSalle St. and Normandy Rd.)
- Public Works Building (Judy Recker Cres.)

Trees will be picked up from these locations into February. These trees are chipped into mulch for town projects, and are also used on Fighting Island for natural regeneration.
