Amherstburg Garbage Collection

- Your garbage will be collected weekly. We request that you locate your street on the maps provided (see next page) and identify which day your street will receive weekly garbage collection. Look for these icons (on right).
- **Large Items & Furniture:** Will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day (with the exception of white goods). Items such as box springs, mattresses, couches, chairs, toilets (separate tank from bowl), and similar materials can be put out on any regular garbage day.
- Garbage shall NOT exceed 45 lbs. (20kg) per container.
- All garbage is to be in a suitable container and at the roadside / curb the night **BEFORE** your collection day.
- **NON-COLLECTABLE Waste:** Waste that is deemed non-collectable includes: Ammunition, animal carcasses, animal waste, appliances, automotive parts, bricks, combustibles, chemical waste, computer equipment, concrete, construction & demolition waste, explosives, industrial waste, liquid waste, medical waste, metal items, pallets, paint products, renovation debris, syringes, televisions, and tires. These items are not garbage and will NOT be collected – **check index for Public Drop Off information.**

Missed Garbage Collections

Missed collections are upsetting, but there is usually a reason why material was not collected as expected.

To ensure your materials are collected, please ensure they are:

- In acceptable containers
- Out the **NIGHT BEFORE** your collection day
- Within the weight limit of 20 kg (45 lbs)
- Not hidden behind a vehicle, snow bank, or other obstruction
- Free of prohibited content (e.g. hazardous or construction/renovation waste)
- Please refrain from placing garbage and recycle bins on sidewalks where possible.

Other reasons for missed collections are:

- Unacceptable containers, i.e. plastic shopping bags
- Not scheduled for collection that particular day
- Non-collectable waste i.e. computer equipment, televisions, renovation debris, animal waste, paint, medical waste, tires, concrete, appliances and metal items.

If an item is not collected for reasons other than the above, please contact Windsor Disposal Service at 519-944-8009. **Please do not leave uncollected material at the curb while you are resolving the problem.**

Please **REVIEW** the route maps on the next page to see when your garbage day will be. If you have any questions, call **Public Works at 519-736-3664.**



White Goods / Appliances:

White Goods are collected the **FOURTH** Thursday of each month with the exception of December, which will be collected on December 20, 2024.

Please call 519-736-3664 to be placed on a list for collection. **Deadline to schedule a pick up is the Friday before collection.**

White Goods include: stoves, fridges, freezers, washers, air conditioners, dryers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, trash compactors, barbecues, and microwaves.

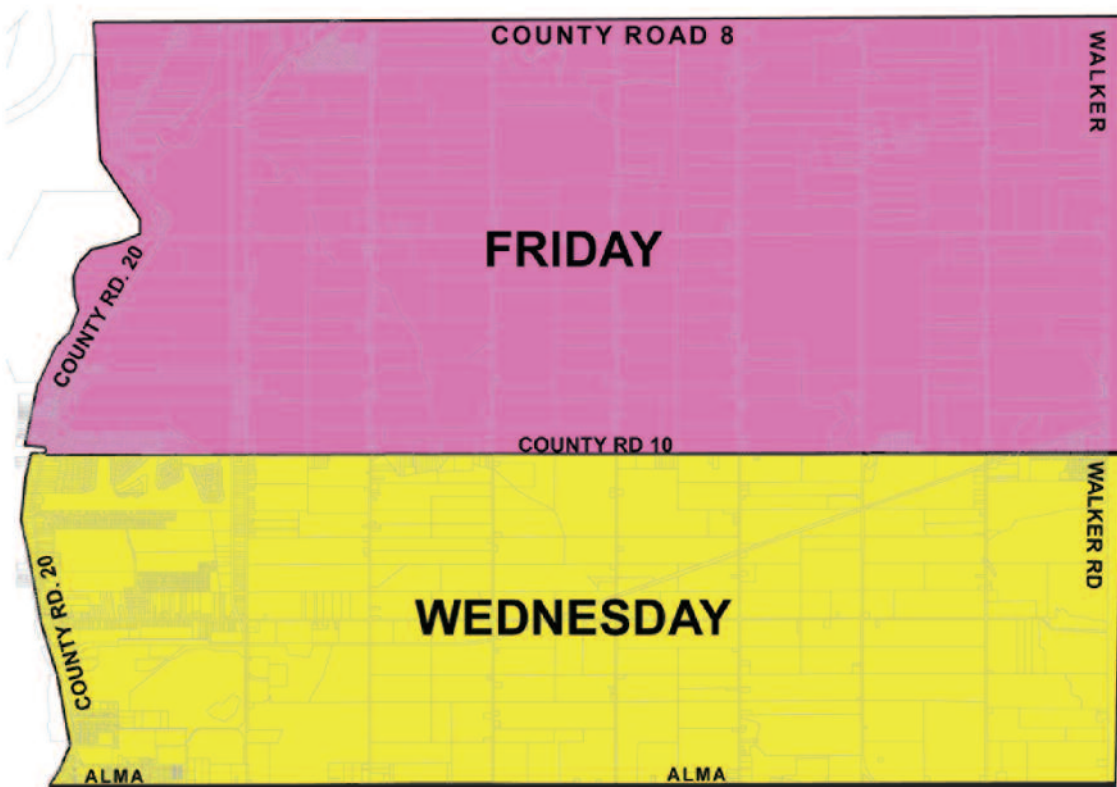

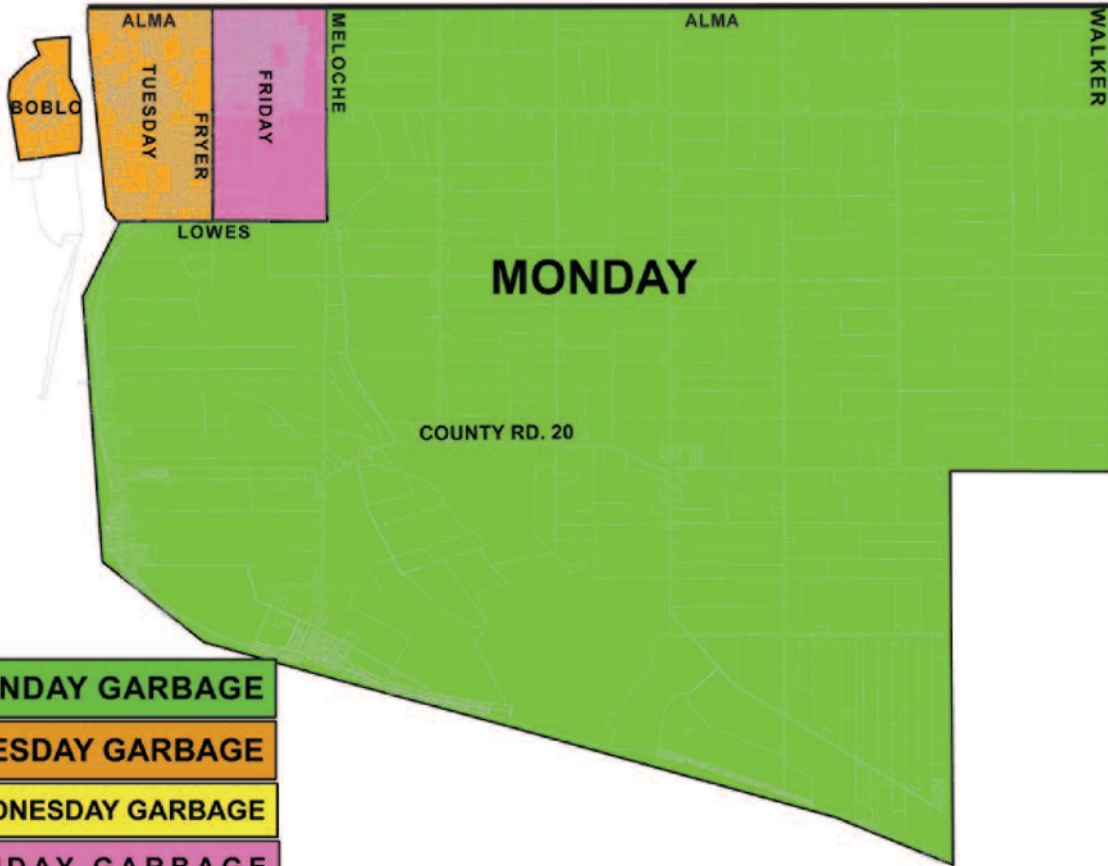

Yard Waste Information

Amherstburg offers roadside yard waste collection.

Yard Waste Roadside Collection:

- **Yard Waste Collection:** Roadside collection is provided on **ALTERNATING MONDAYS IN TWO (2) ZONES FROM APRIL TO DECEMBER**. Consult the Yard Waste Collection Route Maps (see next page) to determine your zone.
- If you are unsure what zone your residence is located in, please call the Public Works Department at 519-736-3664.
- Please ensure that your yard waste is placed at the roadside the **NIGHT BEFORE** your collection day.
- The only **ACCEPTABLE** containers are: Paper Yard Waste Bags, Cardboard Boxes, Garbage Cans / Pails. Note: cardboard boxes are not returned. **Plastic bags containing yard waste will NOT be collected.**
- Tree trimmings must be cut and bundled into four foot lengths and shall be no larger than two feet in diameter. **Unbundled tree trimmings will NOT be collected.**
- Containers and tree trimmings bundles are restricted to weights of 45lbs. (20kg) or less.
- If your pick up falls on a holiday, your yard waste will be collected the Saturday prior to the holiday.

Yard Waste Includes:

Tree & Hedge Trimmings:

Tied in bundles (max. length 4ft. / max. diameter 2 ft.)

Garden Waste / Leaves:

Flowers, vegetables, plants, fruit, and leaves should be put in cardboard boxes, paper yard waste bags, or garbage pails/cans. Leaves raked to the roadside will **NOT** be picked up.

Grass Clippings: Grass clippings are considered **YARD WASTE** and will only be collected at the roadside on Yard Waste Days. Please place in acceptable containers weighing no more than 45lbs. (20kg).

Large Trees & Shrubs: Regular yard waste collection will take branches and brush up to 3" in diameter, if cut and bundled into bundles no larger than 4ft x 2ft in diameter. Bundles must weigh less than 45lbs. (20kg).

Larger items can be taken to one of the Essex-Windsor Solid Waste Authority's Public Drop Off Depots (check the index for more information on these locations).



Acceptable yard waste containers include:
paper yard waste bags, cardboard boxes, garbage cans / pails.
Cardboard boxes are not returned.

Christmas Trees

Prior to placing your Christmas trees at the roadside, please remove ornaments, bags and stands.

Please have your Christmas trees out for collection at the roadside on the following dates:

- Monday, January, 6th, 2025
- Monday, January, 13th, 2025



This is for **Christmas Trees ONLY**. Yard Waste will **NOT** be collected.

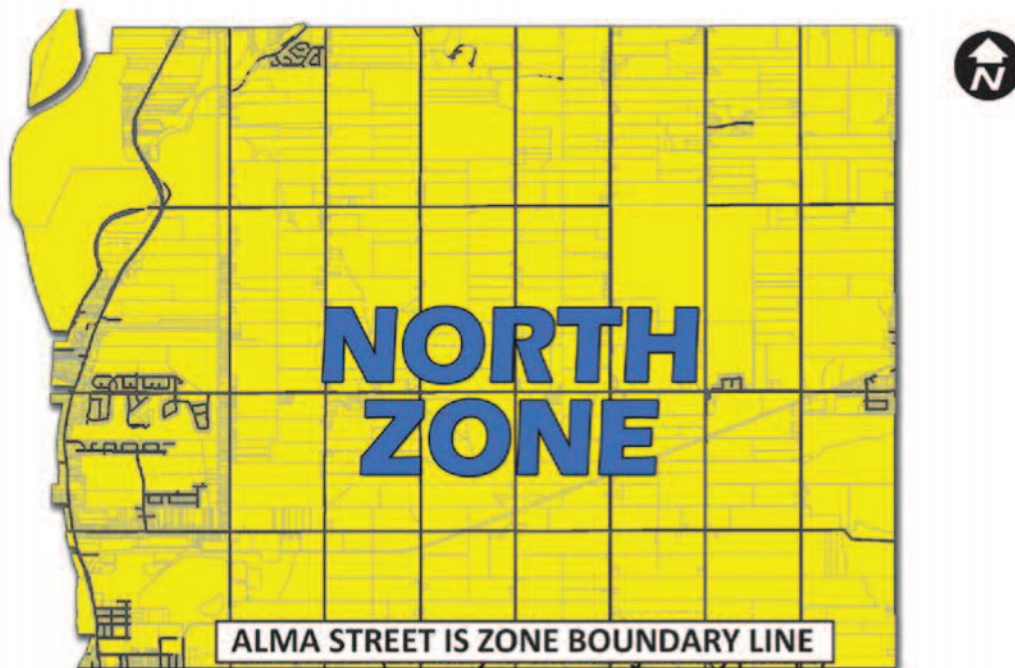

No Grease Down The Drain

A message from Public Works

Grease is a by-product of cooking. It comes from meat, lard, oil, shortening, butter, margarine, food scraps, baking goods, sauces and dairy products. When grease washes down the sink, it sticks to the insides of the pipes that connect your home or business to the Town's sewer. It also coats the insides of the Town's sewer pipes. Eventually, the grease can build up until it completely blocks sewer pipes. That can create difficult and expensive maintenance problems for both the Town and private property owners.

How You Can Help?

Don't pour grease down sink drains or toilets. Scrape grease and food scraps into the trash or pour grease into a disposable container, let it harden and throw it in the garbage.

Other Items That Should Not Be Flushed

- disposable diapers
- cleaning wipes (even if flushable)
- paper towels
- unused medications
- feminine hygiene products
- bandages and bandage wrappings
- cotton balls and swabs
- razor blades and needles

The only thing you should ever flush down a toilet is toilet paper.

Anything else can block pipes, cause mechanical problems at pump stations or treatment plants, and pollute the environment.



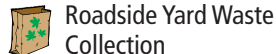

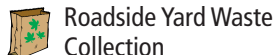

Basement Flooding Subsidy Program

The Town of Amherstburg is offering a financial subsidy to:

- Disconnect foundation drains that are connected to the sanitary sewer;
- Install a back water valve on the internal plumbing system in existing homes;
- Install a sump pump overflow to discharge outside to surface (applies to existing sump pumps only);

The Town is offering a downspout disconnection service to residents on the Amherstburg wastewater collection system FREE of charge.

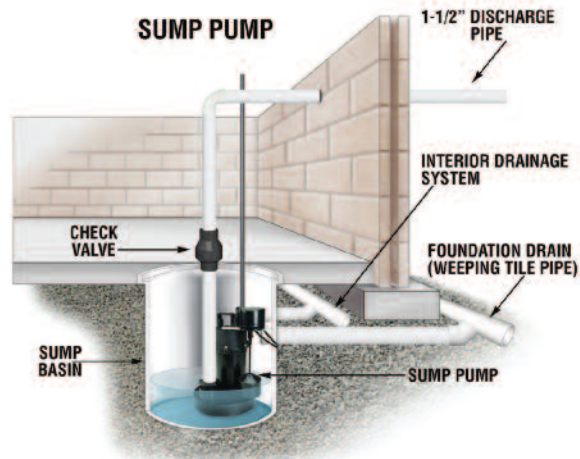
Additional Tips to Reduce the Risk of Flooding

- Ensure there are no cracks in storm water piping around the house
- Ensure no cracks or holes in the basement walls or floors that may allow water to enter the basement
- Provide backup power supply to the sump pump

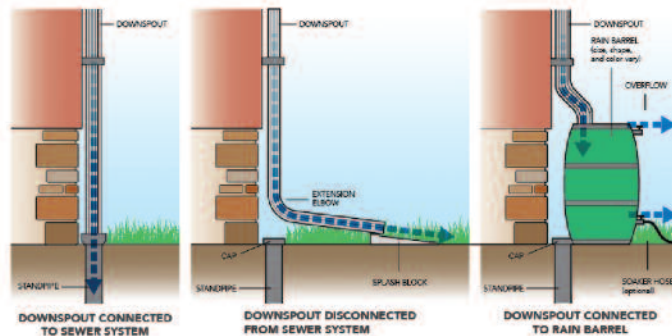


Back Water Valve

Downspout Disconnection



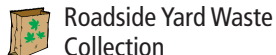

Did you know? Steel is the world's most recycled material. It can be recycled infinitely without deteriorating and recycling steel consumes around 60% less energy than it takes to manufacture virgin steel from iron ore.

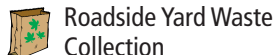
