Five Key Things To Know To Be Ready for the October Launch

1. **Your collection day:** Check your collection calendar for weekly collection dates. Download Recycle Coach for updates.
2. **Your set-out time:** Put your Green Bin out by 6 AM on your collection day.
3. **How to use your Green Bin:** Know the do's and don'ts of using your Green Bin. Refer to the information in your Starter Kit.
4. **What bags to use:** Only compostable bags can be used as liners in your Kitchen Catcher.
5. **Proper Bin set-out:** Use the "Park-Point-Space" method of setting out your Green Bin for collection.

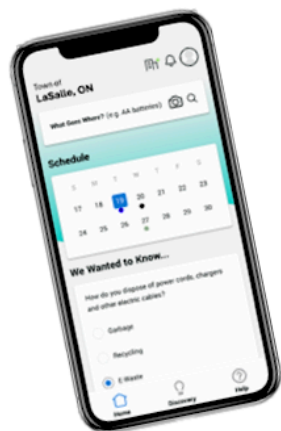
